## Now Accepting **EMPTY** Aerosol Containers

Please place **EMPTY** aerosol containers from the following categories with your container recycling:

# YES

- discard lids in trash

- do not puncture, pierce, flatten or remove nozzles



**Health and Beauty Aids:** Sun block, Hairspray, Hair Mousse, Shaving Cream, Deodorants



**Laundry**



**Food containers:** Frostings, cooking spray, whipped cream, processed cheeses



**Air Fresheners**

**All other types of aerosol containers will be rejected.** Empty aerosols that once contained hazardous materials are not acceptable. These aerosols include, but are not limited to: spray paint, pesticides, cleaning products, craft products, adhesives, automotive sprays, waterproofing sprays, WD-40 and other lubricants. These *empty* aerosols should be disposed with your solid waste. If full, or partially full, they need to be disposed at a Household Hazardous Waste Collection.
